Additional Deposits Required for Requested Food Services and Special Activities

Lodging

Asbury Lodge (52 beds)	\$600/night
Asbury lodge has 4 bedrooms, 2 multi-use bathrooms (3 showers, sinks, toilets in each), large kitchen and meeting area, fire ring and a large porch	
North Cabin (24 beds)	\$350/night
South Cabin (24 beds)	\$350/night
North and South cabins have 2 bedrooms, 2 private bathrooms, kitchen and meeting area, shelter house, fire ring and a large porch	
Middle Cabin (18 beds)	\$350/night
Middle cabin includes 9 bunk beds between 3 rooms, 2 private bathrooms, kitchen and meeting area, picnic area and a fire ring.	
Staff House--Large Side (5 beds)	\$300/night
The staff house includes 5 twin sized beds in 3 bedrooms, 2 private bathrooms, each with a shower/tub combination, a full sized kitchen, large meeting area and small porch area on the second story	
Staff House -- Apartment Side (1 bed)	\$150/night
The apartment side of the staff house includes 1 bedroom, 1 bathroom, a full kitchen, small meeting area, and a carport.	
The Entire Staff House	\$400/night
Coldsmith Lodge Area (24 beds) -- Seasonal	\$200/night
Primitive camping includes: 4 A-Frames, central bathhouse, picnic area, and central lodge, fireplace and kitchen. Open from mid-April to mid-October	
Tents	\$6/person/night
Outback area with picnic area access and access to Coldsmith bathhouse or pool bathhouse.

Family Rates

Lodging and Meals: Children 0 to 5 years of age are **Free**

Day Use Rates: \$20/family/day

Special Activities: Children 0 to 3 years of age are free

Food Service -- Minimum of 20 persons

Full Service -- Breakfast, Lunch and Supper

Continental Breakfast only

Full Breakfast only

Supper only

Snack

Meal service can be provided to groups of less than 20, if the group agrees to the minimum charge of 20 persons.

Each cabin has a kitchenette with utensils and dishes for the number in which it sleeps for groups wishing to prepare their own meals.

Additional charges may be required for special or specific menu items and/or planning. Snacks must be paired with one other meal.

Special Activities

****All activities MUST BE scheduled through the camp office prior to reserved dates. All activities are weather dependent. Completed release forms are required for all participants.**

Trail Rides **\$25/person, 90 min. session (\$275 minimum)**

All trail riders must be over 4th grade, under 250 lbs, and pass the arena test

Lead Rides **\$7/person/ride (\$50 minimum)**

Lead rides are given at the discretion of the camp staff for those not qualified to participate in trail rides:

250 lb. weight limit

Wagon Rides (Tractor) **\$40/session**

Low Ropes Course **\$10/person, 90 min. session (\$100 minimum)**

Recommended size of group: 10-15 participants

Pedal Boats and Canoeing **\$8/person, 1 hour session, max 25 people/session**

Pedal boats may be substituted for participants at discretion of camp staff. Weight requirements followed according to craft specification

Swimming Pool **\$3/person or \$50/hour**

Archery **\$5/person, 1 hour session, (\$50 minimum)**

AV Equipment **\$25/day (includes setup)**

Fishing **\$5/person, 1.5 hour session (\$50 minimum)**

Staffing, fishing poles, and bait supplied

Group Contact Person -- It is the responsibility of the contact person of each group to whom this mailing is addressed to, to fully inform everyone within their group prior to their event, of the Policies Governing Reservations (see booklet) here at Camp Chippewa. All visitors are required to observe all rules and regulations set in the Policies Governing Reservations at Camp Chippewa.

Deposit(s) must be sent with a signed confirmation form to hold the requested dates, or services. The deposit(s), less a \$25.00 handling fee, will be refunded if you group cancels 60 days prior to the date reserved, canceling within 60 days, no deposit will be refunded. All deposits will be subtracted from the final billing provided there are no damages or excessive cleaning expenses. If scheduling within 60 days of reservation date there is no refund of any deposit money, should your group cancel. There is no refund of deposit(s) for dates canceled after a reschedule.
